It is imperative that we know these details. Please kindly advise.	The pipe is owned by a third party, and it is a Gas Pipe. Bidders are to refer to the attached Layouts for details of Servitudes.
2	The current tender requirements for the role of Construction Manager, Site Agent, Contractor's Representative and Lead Consultant only refer to an Engineering qualification. These roles are also largely performed by professionals in the Built Environment that have qualifications in Construction Management, Building Science, Construction Studies, and Quantity Surveying etc. For this reason, we hereby request that the Employer amend the current requirement to encompass both Engineering and the Built Environment qualifications.	The specification of this RFP is in line with the Complexity and Magnitude of the Project.

3	<p>Confirmation has been obtained from ECSA that structural engineering is not a separate registration category because it falls within the civil engineering discipline. Accordingly, structural engineers are professionally registered with ECSA under civil engineering. 5	<p>We respectfully request confirmation that the tender submission by GVK Siya Zama Consortium, with the attendance register reflecting GVK Siya Zama, will be regarded as compliant, notwithstanding that not all consortium members attended the site inspection.</p>	<p>TASEZ confirms that the below will be compliant.</p>
6	<p>Item 1.9.1 and Item 1.9.2 differ in their wording and intent.</p> <p>Please confirm that we as the lead partner can submit our ISO 9001 certificate to comply with item 1.9.</p>	<p>TASEZ replaces Clauses 1.9.1 and 1.9.2 with the following.</p> <p>Where Tenderers enter into JVs or Consortium Agreements, both the Contractor(s) and Engineering Firm(s) must submit separate ISO 9001: 2015 Certificates.</p>

7	<p>The 50,000 m² will only be the warehouse. Tenderers are to optimise space within the warehouse and accommodate as much as possible without compromising floor space.
